## **PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT POLICY**

This Partnership Agreement Policy outlines the principles, expectations, and guidelines that govern all partnerships and collaborations with Gilys Children's Foundation.

### **1. Purpose of Partnerships**

Promote transparency, integrity, and shared accountability in all joint activities.

### **Build Networks**

Build networks that enhance community impact, resource mobilization, and sustainability.

### **2. Types of Partnerships**

Gilys Children's Foundation engages in different forms of partnerships, including:

Funding Partners

Donors and organizations that provide financial support for specific projects.

## **Program Partners**

NGOs, schools, or community groups that help implement shared initiatives.

## **Corporate Partners**

Businesses that contribute through donations, CSR programs, sponsorships, or in-kind support.

Maintain open communication and cooperation throughout the partnership

**6. Monitoring and Reporting**

All partnership projects are subject to regular monitoring and evaluation to ensure goals are achieved effectively.

Reports will include:

Project progress and outcomes

Financial accountability and transparency records

Beneficiary impact stories and photos (where appropriate)

Partners may also conduct joint reviews or site visits by mutual arrangement.

**7. Duration and Renewal**

Strategic collaborations

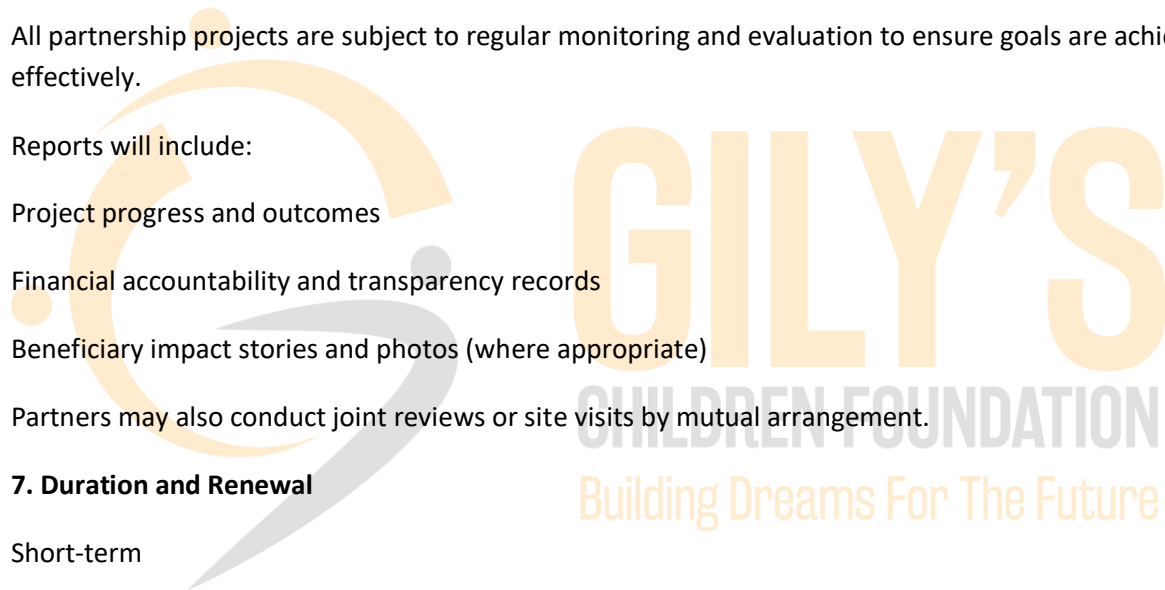
All agreements specify their duration and renewal terms. Renewals are based on performance, results, and mutual interest in continuing the partnership.

**8. Termination**

Either party may terminate a partnership agreement by written notice if:

The partnership no longer aligns with organizational goals.

There is a breach of the agreed terms or misuse of resources.



Ethical or legal violations occur.

Any unfulfilled financial or project obligations will be settled fairly and transparently.

## **9. Public Acknowledgment**

Gilys Children's Foundation values its partners and acknowledges their contributions publicly, unless anonymity is requested.

Acknowledgment may include:

Mentions on our website or social media

Logos on campaign materials or reports

Joint visibility in media coverage or events

All use of names or logos will be done with prior written consent.

## **10. Confidentiality**

Both Gilys Children's Foundation and its partners agree to protect all confidential or sensitive information shared during the partnership.

Such information will not be disclosed to third parties without mutual consent, unless required by law

## **11. Compliance and Ethics**

All partnerships must adhere to:

The Foundation's Child Protection Policy

The Financial Accountability Policy

Relevant local and international laws

Ethical standards that promote respect, equality, and inclusion

We maintain a zero-tolerance approach to corruption, discrimination, or exploitation in any partnership.
